



Example of a curriculum plan for 3 year PhD program

This is an example of the distribution of coursework and research in the course of three years. Students are advised to discuss their individual plan of studies with their supervisor in order to tailor the plan to their specific needs. It is however recommended that students complete the core coursework in the first two semesters of their study. Electives can be taken in any order the student wishes. There is no specific limit on the number of courses per semester, but the plan should be discussed and agreed upon with the supervisor.

Please note that the plan below is based on the minimum number of credit points that can be collected for each course or activity. Electives from Group A and Group B have different credit point numbers. The total number of credit points in this example is 30.
